Maggie survived a car accident that took her mother's life and left the 9-year-old a quadriplegic and ventilator-dependent. Following her recovery in

rehab, her grandparents became her full time caregivers. One of Maggie's biggest daily hurdles was getting in and out of her bed. Thanks to TRF's ceiling lift, Maggie's grandparents can now help her safely move from bed to wheelchair.

Bryce was participating in an athletic competition when he flipped over his mountain bike, leaving him a quadriplegic. After the accident, he struggled to sleep through the night and the thought of pressure sores worried him. The TRF granted Bryce a special mattress and adjustable bed that reduced the risk of skin sores. Today, Bryce can sleep comfortably with proper circulation and support.

Travis Roy was a freshman Boston University hockey player in 1995 when a tragic accident in his first college game left him a quadriplegic. For 25 years, his Foundation has helped spinal cord injury survivors live more independent and hopeful lives. The Foundation funds grants for adaptive equipment for SCI survivors and supports medical research aimed at finding cures for paralysis.

Sadly, Travis passed away on October 29th, 2020 from complications related to his paralysis.

OUR WIFFLE BALL TOURNAMENT

After his accident, Travis focused on helping other spinal cord injury survivors. Inspired by Travis' story, a community of volunteers came together in 2002 in the rolling hills of Essex, Vermont, for a one-day backyard **WIFFLE BALL TOURNAMENT**. Seven teams played to raise money and awareness for the Travis Roy Foundation.

Twenty years later, the tournament has grown to 32 teams and hundreds of players who are supported by thousands of donors and fans.
